The school now has approximately 320 students and 40 staff employed. AIS has 10 classes in the PYP (Grade 1-5) and 6 classes in the MYP (Grade 6-10) and is currently registered as an authorised world school in both the Primary Years Programme and the Middle Years Programme.</p> <p>So far the school has representation from over 40 nationalities within a small school community and looks forward to expanding this representation to create a truly international environment.</p> |


